After a 7 years fellowship, appointed senior registrar from 1986 to 1993 then promoted as a senior consultant from 1993 to 2009. Expert in cutting edge diagnosis tools and treatments for variety of cancer patients with special emphasis on lymphoma, Hodgkin's Lymphoma, myeloma, acute and chronic leukemias, myeloproliferative and myelodysplastic syndromes.
- Appointed consultant in leading French Institutions for cancer treatment: 1986 at Saint-Louis Hospital in Paris (Prof. E. Gluckman) and in 1998 at Henri-Mondor Hospital in Paris (Prof. F. Reyes).
